



2005 Midwest Championship Hillclimb Invitational
September 3rd & 4th, 2005 - Red Wing, MN

Indianhead Motorcycle Club is pleased to invite you to compete in the 2005 Midwest Championship Hillclimb Invitational! The top 10 riders in each class from AMA Districts 15, 16, 17, and 23, as well as KS/MO as of July 18th, 2005 automatically qualify for their respective classes, as do the top 5 riders from each 2004 King of the Hill Championship Series (top 5 from IL/IN and top 5 from MN/WI) for the King of the Hill Grudge Match. Additional riders may be extended special invitations at the discretion of IMC.

The following classes will be run at the Championship:

50cc auto (Max. 10" rear wheel - 4-8 years old)	65cc (6-11 years old)
Jr. Mini (85cc 7-11 years old)	Sr. Mini (85cc 12-15 years old)
86-125cc	126-200cc
201-250cc	251-450cc
451-600cc	601-750cc
Open	86-600cc 4-Stroke
Senior (40+ years old)	Super Senior (50+ years old)
2-Stroke ATV	
4-Stroke ATV	<i>King of the Hill*</i>
Pit Bike Challenge	<i>King of the Hill Grudge Match*</i>

**The King of the Hill class will be run each day (scored as a 2-event series with one award) with the 10 fastest riders of the day. The King of the Hill Grudge Match will run Saturday night, with the top 5 from last year's KOTH series (IL/IN and MN/WI). These classes will not require an additional entry fee.*

Each rider may ride in up to 3 classes (as qualified or per special invitation, not including KOTH classes or the Pit Bike class). The Championship is a 2-event series, consisting of one event Saturday and one event Sunday. Only one entry fee is required per class, which covers both days of competition. As a “thank you” from IMC for attending the event, each rider will receive a coupon for a free meal at the concession stand and free admission at the gate.

Gate fees for non-riders are \$7.00 each day, or \$12.00 for the weekend. Children 6 and under get in free.

Awards will be given on Sunday based on the series results using on the following points schedule:

1st place = 100 points	6th place = 84 points
2nd place = 96 points	7th place = 82 points
3rd place = 92 points	8th place = 81 points
4th place = 89 points	9th place = 80 points
5th place = 86 points	10th place = 79 points

...continuing down by 1 point per place. Any ties in points at the end of Sunday’s event will be broken by averaging all 4 rides for each affected rider. Ties during either Saturday or Sunday will be broken based on the riders’ other (2nd best) ride. The King of the Hill class will be scored based on the same placement schedule used for the 2003 KOTH Championship Series events - in the event of a tie for first place, those two riders will have a one-run run-off (ties for other places will not be broken). Awards will be presented to the top ten in each regular class based on their final series standing at the end of Sunday’s event. There will be a premium KOTH Midwest Championship award and \$100 cash provided to the series winner of the King of the Hill class, provided by www.KingOfTheHill.org.

There will be two extra classes at the Championship. First, there will be a Pit Bike Championship - this is an open entry class with 100% payback. Second, there will be a King of the Hill Grudge Match, pitting the top 5 from both 2004 KOTH Championship Series in head-to-head competition, with no entry fee, a premium Grudge Match award and \$100 cash going to the winner. Details on these two classes:

Pit Bike Challenge: Saturday after all regular classes

- \$5.00 Entry Fee - 100% Payback
- One run event
- Basic protective gear required (helmet, long pants, etc.)
- 50cc limit for riders up to 170 pounds
- 110cc limit for riders over 170 pounds
- Bikes must be "pit bikes" - i.e. not MX-class machines (no YZ80s, KX100s, etc.)
- Riders must weigh-in prior to riding
- Riders must be 15 to 65 years old

King of the Hill Grudge Match: Saturday after Pit Bike class

- Top 5 riders from each 2004 KOTH Championship Series (IL/IN and MN/WI) qualify
- No additional fee
- Premium Grudge Match award plus \$100 cash provided by King of the Hill (www.KingOfTheHill.org)
- All riders must ride 451-600cc class machines
 - This is to even the playing field, to emphasize the rider, and not the machine
- Riders are permitted to borrow a 451-600cc machine if they do not own one (from a non-grudge match rider - the same bike cannot be ridden by 2 riders)
- One run event



No camping is available on IMC club grounds. There are a number of hotels/motels in the Red Wing, MN area all within a few minutes of the hill. Riders and their families may camp at Kaleb Northrup's house about 15 minutes from Red Wing if they like - several acres of land available and access to a bathroom/shower - contact Kaleb Northrup at Motoman@KingOfTheHill.org or 651-303-3957 for more information. Signs will be posted leading to the club grounds from downtown Red Wing on race days - here are turn-by-turn directions as well:

- From Highway 61, turn south (away from the river) on West Ave.
- Follow West Ave. to Seventh (7th) St. - then turn left on Seventh.
- You'll just go to the next intersection, then turn right on East Ave.
- Follow East Ave. to Twelfth (12th) St. - turn right on Twelfth.
- Follow Twelfth St. to Seymour St. - turn right on Seymour.
- From Seymour St, turn left on Chestnut St.
- Finally, from Chestnut St. turn left onto Bohmbach Dr., which is right by the city baseball fields and a church. Bohmbach will lead you right into our gates.
- Note that when leaving, obviously you just reverse these directions, but don't turn off of East Ave. - East Ave. will run straight to Highway 61 (portions of East and West Avenues are one-way).

Entry forms must be postmarked by August 11th, 2005 to ensure proper registration. IMC may extend special invitations to riders who otherwise would not qualify to ensure full classes and representation of top riders. Riding order will be the inverse of the order that entries were received - the first rider to register rides last, and the last rider to register rides first (the rider leading a class after the first round may choose to run last in the second round, if they would prefer - all other riders ride in order).

Please be aware that **NO** entries will be accepted on race day! We will have all of our scoring forms, riding orders, etc. ready to go before we even get to the hill on Saturday, so please do not just show up on Saturday (or Sunday) and expect to sign up and race!
